- Option 1:** 1 time payment of \$1,150 for 1 bushel every week for 18 weeks (feeds 8-10)
- Option 2:** 1 time payment of \$610 for ½ bushel every week for 18 weeks (feeds 4-6)
- Option 3:** 1 time payment of \$360 for 1 peck every week for 18 weeks (feeds up to 2)

## Van Houtte Farms 2022 CSA Program Terms & Conditions

**Registration:** This year we will be limiting the number of CSA spots to 60 due to limited space on our market trucks. CSA registration ends on May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022 or when we have reached capacity. No CSA registrations will be accepted after that date.

**Payment:** CSA subscriptions are to be paid in full before the first pickup date. Accepted payment types include check or debit/credit card. The customer also acknowledges that payments posted for the subscription on their debit/credit card will be posted as either Van Houtte Farms or The Flour Shoppe.

**Cancellation:** After payment has been accepted, there is no opportunity for cancellation or a refund.

**Pickup Commitment:** To ensure each customer receives their subscription, registered pick up locations **CANNOT** be changed. Each customer is required to pick up their subscription at their designated location during the designated pickup times. Failure to do so will result in the loss of that week's subscription basket with no refund.

**Contents:** Each weekly subscription will include vegetables that are in season. Van Houtte Farms will put forth its best effort to ensure that the product is fresh and of the highest quality, based on the season's growing and environmental conditions (weather etc.) Van Houtte Farms reserves the right to determine subscription contents based on such factors and availability.

## Program Details and FAQ's

---

Van Houtte Farms is a 2<sup>nd</sup> generation farm located in Armada, Michigan. Our 100-acre farm offers a large variety of seasonal produce. This will be our 8<sup>th</sup> year of offering discounted produce subscriptions!

### Program Overview:

- The 2022 CSA program is available from June through September or first Saturday of October depending on pickup day chosen. (18 weeks).
- Each subscription receives either a peck, ½ bushel, or full bushel of produce every week.
- Customer picks up their subscriptions at either Royal Oak Market, Pontiac Market, or our farm in Armada (32/Romeo Plank).

**Core offerings:** Strawberries, asparagus, lettuce, herbs, peas, potatoes, rhubarb, zucchini, summer squash, pickles, cucumbers, kale, cabbage, cauliflower, eggplant, brussels sprouts, green and yellow beans, swiss chard, kohlrabi, broccoli, watermelon, melons, tomatoes (different varieties) corn, rutabaga, winter squash, pie pumpkins, sweet and hot peppers, beets and carrots.

\*Each subscription also receives two standard carving pumpkins in October, which will be available for pick up at our farm in Armada.
